## The Pavilion Project – work commences

The decision of Council was whether to redevelop the Community Room first, or get on with the essential work of extending the family accommodation for the Grounds Manager. In the event, the scaffold goes up in early June to extend the roof area with a full width dormer to the rear. While construction firm Loftplan are doing the work, Graeme and his family will continue to live there and take care of the Recreation Ground.

## Renewable Energy

At the same time the log boiler is being installed in the building using local logs as fuel, so reducing our carbon footprint and our dependency on inefficient electric heating. That work will be paid for by a grant from the Low Carbon Building Programme and the Community Sustainability Energy Programme. Please let us know if you have a large branch or tree we can take away to use as winter fuel.

## News from the Parish Council

The Parish Council is delighted to have two new Councillors: Alison Ellwood, who lives with her family in Sunningdale; and Robin Booth whose family have long been active in affairs of Sunningdale and the constituency.

The Council continues to take up all civic matters, including yellow lines, parking matters, rubbish bins, trees, footpaths, the cemetery, allotment management, and scrutinising all planning applications. Council pursues all available funds that have been generated from S106 developers contribution. From that money we have secured funding for cricket practice nets which are the latest piece of equipment at the Recreation ground.

The Village Hall, owned by the Parish Council, has been a matter of major concern this year with the ending of the 100 year lease in 2008. A new lease is being drawn up in a joint venture with the CMI to co-sponsor and manage the operations of the Village Hall to ensure it continues to be well maintained for the use of the community.
