- 5 Windsor Rural Development Control Panel representations on behalf of the Parish

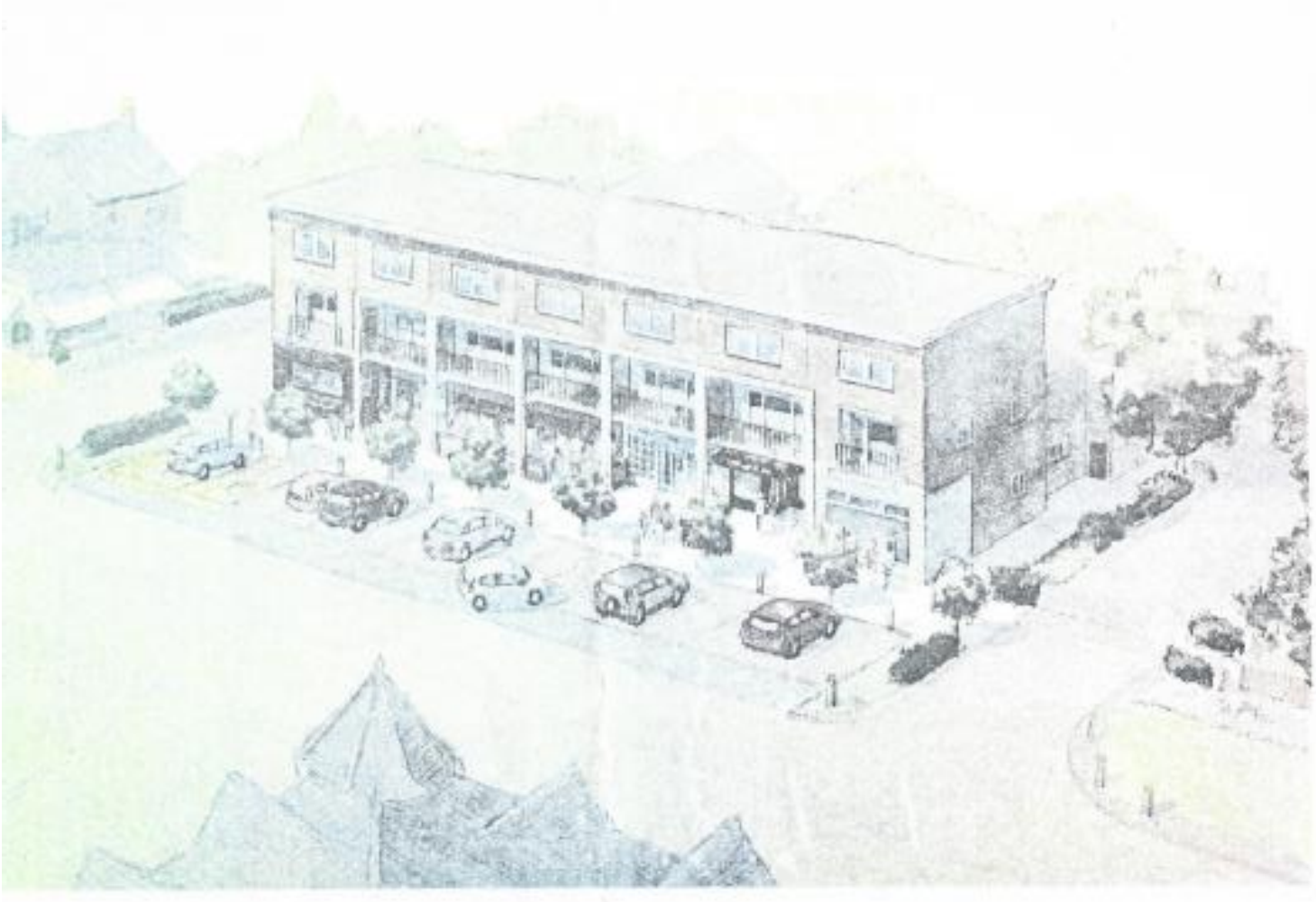
Christmas Event 2017



Residents Survey 2017

- 50:50 split between those who feel involved in village life and those who do not
- Over half the responders said they attended the Christmas event and would love more events such as open air cinema, music in the park
- Majority were very happy with the facilities at Broomhall Lane Recreation Ground, including the library and chalet café
- Around 50% agreed they would participate in village fund raising events for more and better facilities in the village
- Many comments on improvements related to services delivered by RBWM: conditions of roads, footpaths, roadside verges and woodland and tree management
- A high proportion of responders requested speed limits in the village to be reduced or extended
